





#### **Kerbside Household Waste Collected**







# Commercial (municipal non-household) waste managed per inhabitant










#### Packaging Waste Managed - SR v's National



#### Packaging Waste Recovered - SR v's National












- % of households with a residual collection service ONLY


#### % of Households with an Organic Collection Service
